Wicked problems and integrated governance

Aim and scope of the session:

This session is intended to present, reflect and understand what are the critical success factors for integrated governance, targeting with particular attention, the leadership model, the participation of the stakeholders, communication and monitoring / evaluation, the generation or dissipation of trust, resulting from the interaction of all of the above mentioned elements.

In the order to deepen the initial analysis model, a GovInt Matrix proposal is presented as an approach to this organizational model as well as a set of general guiding principles for the development of integrated governance, inspired by the dynamics of complex adaptive systems.

Potential topics (two topics):

- Reflect on complex problems and promoting integrated governance models (GovInt). Its conceptual basis is "building, developing and maintaining inter-relations of cooperation, to manage complex problems more effectively and efficiently."
- Understand what are the critical success factors for integrated governance and present a GovInt Matrix Proposal
