Priority is given to studies that analyse how gastronomic services (restaurants, local producers, culinary experiences), can also function as drivers for economic and social development. The session welcomes theoretical and empirical contributions on gastronomic tourism, value chain dynamics, local production and distribution, innovation, sustainability and territorial governance. Interdisciplinary studies that critically address sustainability, territorial cohesion, economic revitalisation and the socio-economic transformation of peripheral and economically depressed areas are particularly encouraged.
